- What size system will you install?

- What equipment brands do you usually install?
- How long will the installation process take?
- What happens if you don't finish the work on time?
- Will I still get a bill from my utility company?

## Lease information

- How much are the monthly payments?
- How long is the contract?
- If a contract of the contract before the term is up? If so, what are they?
- Is there a production guarantee in the lease agreement? What is it?
- Is there an escalator clause in the contract? What is the escalator rate?
- What happens at the end of the lease? What options do I have?
- Can I cancel the contract before installation begins? Is there a fee to do so?
- Is the lease financing provided through a different company? If so, what company?
- What happens to my lease if I sell my house?

### Warranties and repairs

- How is the system monitored? What monitoring system do you use?
- Oo I, as a customer, have access to system monitoring?
- What type of warranty coverage do you provide?
- What types of damages are covered under your warranty?

- Or an you provide references of at least three satisfied customers?
